Recommended Sequence

WMST 101 or WMST 113 is a prerequisite to WMST 301

WMST 301 is a prerequisite to WMST 302

WMST 301 (Spring only) – Taken spring of junior year (or earlier)

WMST 302 (Fall only) – Taken first semester senior year (or earlier)

WMST 497 (Spring only) – Taken final semester (or earlier)

Notes

- Requirements for a minor in Gender and Sexuality Studies include 21 credit hours in the discipline.
- All minor courses must be completed with a grade of C or higher.
- Must have an overall 2.0 or higher GPA in minor courses.
- At least 9 credits must be earned at UNLV.
- 15 credits must be upper division (300-400 level).
